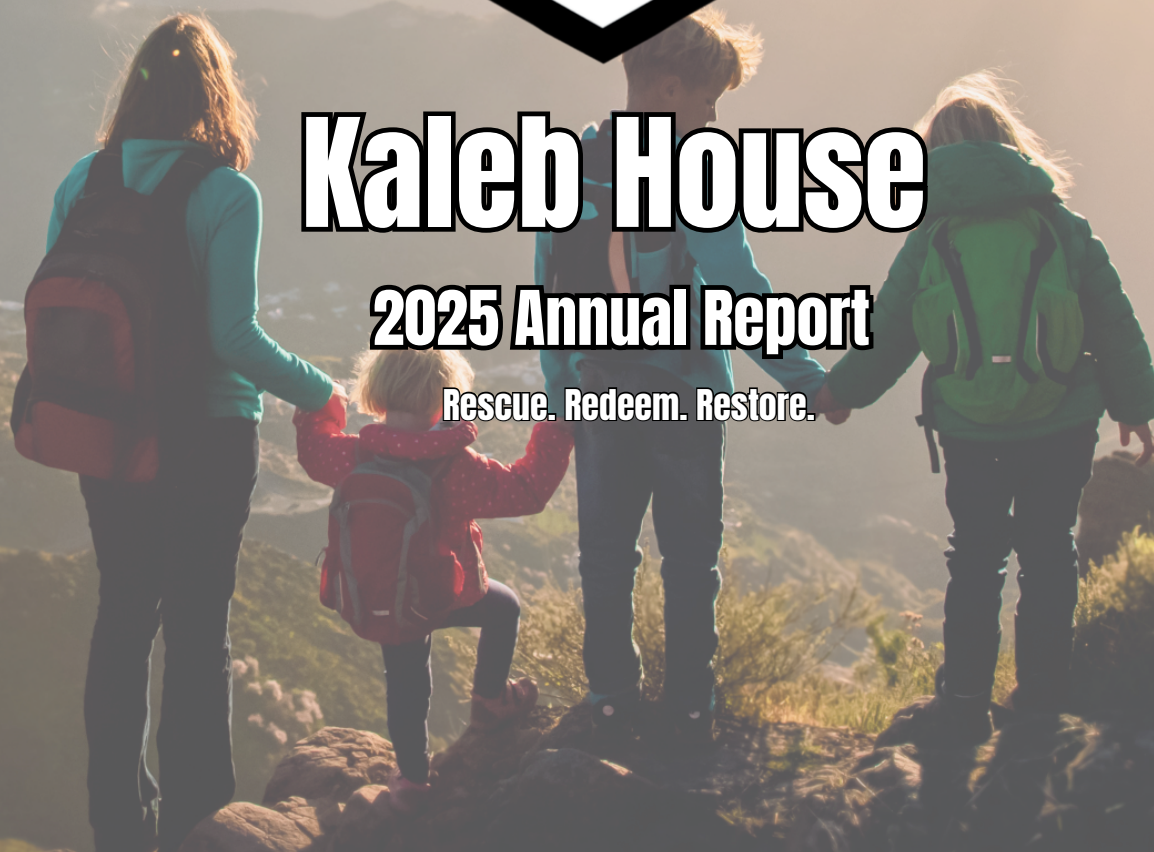

2025 IMPACTS- METRICS OF SUCCESS

Investigations & Recovery

- 47 investigative cases supported
- 13 law enforcement agencies assisted
- 8 missing children located or recovered

Survivor Services

- 51 individuals and families supported
- 38 case management/assistance plans developed
- 12 persons receiving ongoing advocacy
- 4 successful orders of protection
- 4 partner organizations referred to Kaleb House

OUR MISSION

Kaleb House exists to **protect vulnerable survivors of human trafficking and exploitation through investigative support, survivor care, and long-term restoration programs.**

Human trafficking remains one of the most devastating crimes affecting vulnerable populations today. Survivors often face overwhelming barriers to recovery, including trauma, lack of resources, and limited access to long-term care.

Kaleb House addresses these challenges through a **three-part approach:**

Investigation & Recovery Support

Providing specialized investigative assistance to help locate missing children and support law enforcement efforts. All investigative assistance is provided 100% free of charge to local police departments that frequently lack the specialized digital investigative skills Kaleb House delivers.

Survivor Services

Kaleb House provides professional support services, including counseling, advocacy, and case management. We offer an individual holistic approach to healing that covers tailored recovery plans from legal support, medical care, dental care, vocational rehabilitation, and relationship education - as well as the flexibility to address individual restoration programs that are often not available through other organizations.

Long-Term Restoration

Ongoing development of a dedicated residential program and campus environment designed to support long-term healing and recovery. Many of our survivors have never seen what a happy, healthy, and safe family environment looks like - and we want to provide that example through our staff, volunteers, and supporters.

Our goal is not only to rescue, but to **restore and rebuild lives.**

99% of the effort in the counter-trafficking space is focused on awareness. But that doesn't help the survivors at all. We are the 1% that stay with them until they are ready to live again. That's what we uniquely provide.



INVESTIGATIONS & RECOVERY SUPPORT

Recovery often begins here.

One of the most unique aspects of Kaleb House is our ability to assist with **specialized digital investigative work** that supports active cases involving missing or exploited individuals. This is always provided 100% free of charge to local police departments.

Our investigative team includes current and former law enforcement officers, former National Security Agency (NSA) analysts, and Open-Source Intelligence (OSINT) experts in the counter-trafficking world. Our field team has been trained by Special Operations Forces and intelligence agents to deliver world-class results in your community.

When law enforcement agencies encounter cases that require additional investigative capabilities, Kaleb House can provide technical support to accelerate the process of locating victims and identifying individuals involved in exploitation.

These efforts involve careful coordination with investigators and agencies working to bring vulnerable individuals to safety – and attacking the criminal networks to ensure evidence-based prosecutions keep these monsters off your streets.

Impact Highlight

Rapid Recovery

This year, Kaleb House supported a case involving a missing minor believed to be involved in an exploitation situation. Through coordinated investigative support and digital analysis, law enforcement was able to locate and recover the child in less than 24 hours.

Moments like these remind us that **speed, skill, and partnership can save lives.**



SURVIVOR SERVICES

Rescue is only the beginning of the recovery journey. As we say, “Rescue is just Day 0 - then the real work begins.”

Survivors of trafficking and exploitation often face profound trauma and complex life challenges. Healing requires compassionate support, professional services, and a lot of patience. Kaleb House has been developing a comprehensive **survivor services framework** designed to address these needs through coordinated care.

Services Provided

- Case Management
- Counseling & Therapy
- Medical Support
- Legal Advocacy
- Life Coaching
- Relationship Education
- Survivor Advocacy

Impact Story

Each survivor’s journey is different. Some arrive after years of exploitation. Others are at the beginning stages of recovery.

What they share is a need for stability, compassion, and long-term support.

Through coordinated services and dedicated staff, Kaleb House is building a system where survivors are not just rescued — they are supported as they rebuild their lives.



BUILDING THE KALEB HOUSE CAMPUS

One of the most significant developments in 2025 was the continued progress toward completing the first **Kaleb House campus**, a dedicated environment where long-term restoration can take place.

Residence Progress

Major construction milestones this year included:

- 5 community buildings completed or in process
- Plumbing installed and pressure tested
- Major progress on infrastructure projects – roads, water, electricity, internet, etc.

Each step moves the campus closer to welcoming survivors into a space specifically designed for healing.

Property Development

The campus property also continued to grow into a sustainable environment. Improvements included:

- A nursery established with 200+ hybrid willow trees
- Irrigation systems installed to support long-term growth and animal husbandry programs
- Continued land stewardship and development for walking trails and recreational therapy.

The vision is to create a place that feels peaceful, scenic, and restorative - a place where survivors can truly begin healing.

PROGRAM GROWTH

As Kaleb House grows, strengthening the organization behind the mission is essential. Part of that is combining timeless biblical principles with cutting-edge, data-driven approaches to restoration.

This year, we began developing a **multidisciplinary team** capable of delivering comprehensive survivor services in-house.

Key roles being developed include:

- Case Management
- Medical/Nursing Services
- Legal Advocacy
- Counseling and Therapy
- Life Coaching

These roles form the foundation of a coordinated support team capable of meeting the complex needs of survivors.

Building strong systems today allows Kaleb House to expand responsibly in the years ahead.



A Note on Images:

On principle, and for regulatory reasons, Kaleb House will never depict an actual survivor nor give any personally identifiable information that could be used to identify someone in our care.

We believe that practice is exploitive, harmful, and dangerous to the survivors in our care.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Community engagement is an important part of preventing exploitation and mobilizing support for survivor recovery.

In 2025, Kaleb House expanded outreach through events, partnerships, and sharing anonymized reports from survivor services.

The purpose behind our events has become unmistakably clear. Through time spent with our supporters each year at the Ruckus events, and in countless moments of community outreach, we see firsthand what these gatherings truly mean.



Our events exist to do more than bring people together. They are designed to strengthen relationships and families to raise a generation of advocates. We want to invest in those who stand with us - equipping adults, teens, and children alike to recognize and speak out against trafficking and exploitation.

But just as importantly, these events are our way of giving back to you.

They create space for connection, for fellowship, and for building a community of people who share the same heart and mission. There's something powerful about being in a place where everyone understands the "why" behind the work.

We see it in the smiles, the tears during baptisms, the way people show up for one another, and the shared determination to fight for those people so often forgotten.



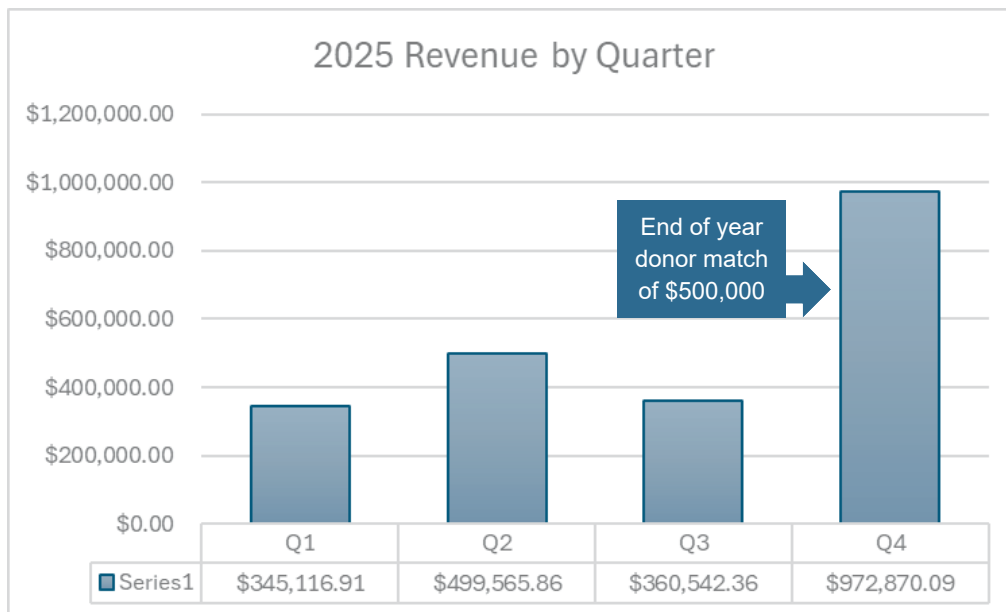
Every time we gather, it feels less like an event and more like a family reunion. And for us, it's a true honor to spend that time with the people who make Kaleb House's work possible.

Program Investments

Financial Stewardship & Mission Impact

At Kaleb House, every dollar entrusted to our organization represents an opportunity to protect survivors, strengthen families, support investigations, and build long-term systems of restoration. In 2025, we remained committed to balancing immediate mission impact with strategic infrastructure growth that positions Kaleb House for sustainable expansion in the years ahead.

2025 Financial Overview

- **Total Expenses:** \$1,913,998

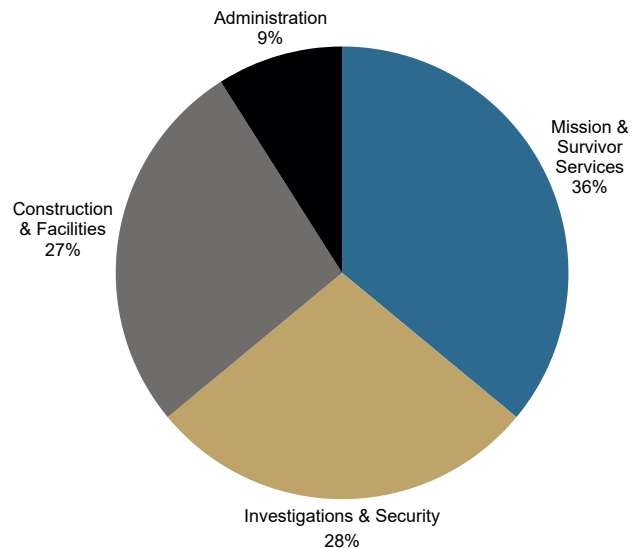
This strong financial position allowed Kaleb House to expand survivor services, strengthen operational capabilities, invest in long-term infrastructure, and deepen collaborative anti-trafficking efforts across Oklahoma.



FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP CONTINUED

Mission & Survivor Support Services

The largest portion of organizational resources directly supported mission delivery and survivor care efforts. This category includes survivor advocacy, family support services, housing assistance, counseling coordination, mission-related travel, legal support services, direct care operations, and practical assistance for vulnerable individuals and families. Payroll for frontline mission personnel, survivor support staff, and operational care teams is also included within this category, reflecting Kaleb House's commitment to investing directly in people and services that create life-changing outcomes for survivors.



Investigations and Security Operations

A foundational portion of Kaleb House resources supported investigative coordination, security operations, and organizational infrastructure necessary for safe and effective anti-trafficking work. This category includes investigative support activities conducted in collaboration with law enforcement, case coordination, operational security functions that protect survivors and staff, communications and intelligence coordination support, and the leadership systems required to sustain rapid-response and field-based operations.

This investment ensures Kaleb House can operate safely in high-risk environments, maintain strong partnerships with law enforcement and allied agencies, and provide immediate, structured support during trafficking investigations and survivor recoveries.

Construction, Equipment & Facilities

Kaleb House made substantial investments in facilities, property development, equipment, and operational infrastructure throughout 2025. This category also includes payroll and support costs directly connected to the construction and property management teams. These expenditures strengthen our ability to provide safe, stable, and mission-ready environments for survivor care, staff operations, training, and future expansion.



FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP CONTINUED

Administration and Community Engagement

Administrative operations at Kaleb House provide the structural backbone that keeps mission work moving efficiently and responsibly. This includes financial management, compliance documentation, insurance coverage, internal audits, human resources, communications and media, donor relations, and essential recordkeeping systems. Together, these functions ensure accountability, protect organizational integrity, and amplify the mission's reach while allowing frontline teams to stay focused on survivor care and investigative impact.

Investing Beyond Immediate Needs

Kaleb House believes meaningful restoration requires more than emergency response alone. Our 2025 financial strategy focused on building sustainable systems that allow us to respond effectively today while strengthening our long-term ability to serve survivors, assist law enforcement, and support families in crisis.

Every financial decision was guided by stewardship, transparency, survivor dignity, and mission effectiveness. Because of the generosity of our supporters and partners, Kaleb House continues to expand its reach and deepen its impact across Oklahoma and beyond.



LOOKING AHEAD TO 2026

The momentum from 2025 positions Kaleb House for significant progress in the coming year.

Key priorities include:
