






Ministry Summary



Ministry Highlights

FAMILY ADVOCACY & REHABILITATION

While progressing on the construction of the Kaleb House facility, we were contacted by an individual who was herself being sexually abused by her husband, as were her children, ages 4 to 12. In our ongoing efforts to forsake not the widow and orphan and to break generational curses, Kaleb House stepped into action.

We rallied our resources and provided this family with an affordable housing option, family court advocacy, life skills training, and access to requisite therapy. Kaleb House has also partnered with a trauma therapist, a family advocate, and security personnel, as is necessary in many abusive situations.

We weren't expecting this first family to lead to a second. And a third. And a fourth. And a fifth. We found ourselves in a situation that required all the efforts of care that the Kaleb House facility provides without having the facility and permanent staffing in place.

The ability to provide the families with these resources was because of the gracious donations we have received through Grindstone Ministries.

DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION

We have secured the land and begun working on water remediation, drainage, and road building. We have demolished poorly constructed facilities to accommodate the proposed administration building and care houses on site. We have also retained the services of a professional architect who has completed the requisite drawings to build Kaleb House and will facilitate the site survey of the property.

PARTNERSHIPS

We have an agreement with a renowned permaculture designer who will donate his time to developing sustainable systems at Kaleb House. We are building strategic partnerships with tradespeople, companies, and organizations who will assist with construction.





Guidelines for Fundraising

MONETARY DONATIONS

Online donations are received through Grindstone Ministries' website. Checks are mailed to the office.

IN-KIND DONATIONS

Donations such as equipment, items for Silent Auctions etc. are processed through and received by the Chief of Staff. Large in-kind donations like equipment are discussed by the Board prior to donation to ensure item is needed for use of Kaleb House.
