1.

Unwavering Faith

Whether it is working with the children in our care, interacting with the community, or testifying in court our faith and resolve in the Father is evident to all. We will not compromise our beliefs and know the Father will see us through all things.

2.

We are part of the 1%

90% Awareness
9% Rescue
1% Restoration
ONLY 1% of all funds given to anti-child trafficking organizations is used to restore children. Kaleb House is part of the 1% of organizations that provide restorative services to victims.

3.

Breaking Generational Curses

Victims of child-trafficking (if they do not receive restorative care) on average abuse 82 more people. Over 3 generations, one person restored is 6,724 saved from abuse. Multiply that by dozens in the last few years that Kaleb House has helped.

4.

Justice for the Hurt

Our Victim's Services team works with local, state, & federal agencies to put abusers behind bars. We want the children we help to feel safe now and in the future knowing their abuser cannot get to them.

5.

100% privately-funded

We do not take government funding. We are 100% funded by individuals, businesses, and organizations that believe in saving and restoring children most of which have a strong faith in Messiah and the Father.

A Calling not a Career Move
